'Safe Partner' Scheme Launched

Following a complete review of Health & Safety at the Gelder Group during the early part of 2011 and in an effort to assure safety at the Group is engrained in to the very finger tips of the organisation, 10 further managers have recently completed the highly rated 'IOSH Managing Safely' course. In addition May sees the Group roll out its 'Safe Partner' scheme that will enable qualifying sub-contractors



to display the Groups new 'Safe Contractor' logos (Pictured). By February 2012 all group sub-contractors will have to register and qualify to the scheme to enable them to receive orders from the Gelder Group.

New Satellite Offices

Two new office openings, one in York and one in Birmingham, have expanded the Gelder Group's trading area by some 43% to now cover 28% of the UK population.

Buoyed by the success of the Group's first satellite office opened in Kings Lynn towards the end of 2009 and the availability of experienced personnel in both York and Birmingham due to the demise of national contractor 'Rok' the group has taken the decision to open two further satellite offices.

Headed by Wayne Richards and overseen by Regional Manager Bill Gillsenan, the Birmingham office opened its doors in early April. Our New office in York opened on 3rd May. The York office is headed by Neil Wright and is overseen by Regional Manager Mick Millership.

On the new office openings Managing Director, Steve Gelder comments "The board and I feel that now is the time to extend

further our trading areas, many of our existing clients have already expressed a requirement for our services in these areas and the current state of the economy, particularly within our industry, means that the right quality of people are available to make these offices an instant success."

Modular Demountable Buildings Division Exceeds all Expectations in 1st Quarter

With public expenditure cutbacks beginning to bite, Gelder Group's Demountable Buildings division has exceeded all expectations by recording full year planned sales of £800k during the first 3 months of 2011.

Demountable Building Division Manager, Pat Richmond comments "Although there is a slowdown in public expenditure many public bodies, such as schools, still require additional space. Our systems represent a fraction of the price of traditional builds and also take a fraction of the time to complete".

Gelder Group's Demountable division is unusual in the fact that we offer the complete service of manufacture, rental, delivery, storage, planning, siting and associated works. Traditionally these services are often procured separately.

Gelder Group Begin Roll Out of Greener Vehicle Fleet

Ten new 'ECOnectic' transit vans have recently been added to the Gelder Group's fleet of over 200 vehicles. 12% more fuel efficient the new vehicles will achieve 39MPG and are far more environmentally cleaner, emitting just 189g/km Co2. These 10 vans will produce 250g/KMCo2 less than standard transits.

The new vehicles will predominately start their lives at the Group's new Birmingham and York Offices and also sport the Groups new van livery in which all phone numbers and office addresses have been dropped in favour of our website address www.gelder.co.uk and a description of the services the company provides.

These new vehicles represent the first expenditure in a planned £600K investment in the Gelder Group's vehicle fleet during 2011 as the company upgrades its fleet with ever more greener and more fuel efficient vehicles over the coming years.
