Hello and Welcome,

What a summer it has been, great weather and loads of evidence that the construction sector is leading the country out of five very tough economic years. Since May our Major Contracts order book has quadrupled from, \pounds 4m to \pounds 16m. Maintenance has followed with year on year orders up 30% and our insurance division has seen its first quarterly increase in claim volumes for 18 months.

Our Major Contracts team live in the 'Real World' when it comes to the economy, they were the first to be hit with a drop in orders in 2008/9 and they are the first to see an upturn, the speed at which it has happened has though surprised us all - I have never seen our order book quadruple in 13 weeks!

"Beware a rising market" is the advise I was recently given, good advice, blocks are now out to 8 weeks, bricks to 12 weeks and steel has gone from 3 weeks to 9 weeks. All this will feed into inflation and there is no industry capacity to absorb this; in short construction prices are on the rise.

Finally, thank you to everyone who voted for me at the Lincolnshire Business Awards. To receive the lifetime achievement award in front of my peers, at the age of 47 was a very proud moment for me. I was literally speechless as the audience of 400 witnessed. I will try my hardest to live up the accolade.
