24 Dwellings Project Complete

On 30th August we handed over 24 houses and flats to Acis Housing at Finningley near Doncaster. The £1.6 million design & build project involved the demolition of an existing RAF residential block including an underground air raid shelter. The contract was completed over a 50 week period

on time and within budget. Acis housing were delighted with the quality of the build and thanked site manager Neil Holt for all his efforts and hard work during the build.



Going Green

Works have now commenced on a £250,000, 8 acre environmental project to the rear of our head office. Local company Fox Group are currently constructing a 1 acre lake (pictured) following which a 50,000 litre grey water system will be installed before 1,000 trees, shrubs and about half an acre of reed beds will be planted. Weather permitting the project will be completed by Christmas and will then extract from the atmosphere 960 tonnes of carbon dioxide annually, completely offsetting the Group's carbon footprint. This will make the Group one of the first carbon neutral companies in the United Kingdom.
